Big Idea

Putting God first in your life brings blessings.

Memory Verses

“Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.”  **Hebrews 10:23**

Family Questions

1. What was the story about today?
2. God made us, so He understands everything about us—including all our hopes and dreams. Have you ever hoped for something very special? What was it? What gift was Chris hoping to get for his birthday? *Answer: a new video game.*
3. How many descendants did God promise to Abraham? How many stars do you think there are in the sky? Read  **Genesis 15:5-6**
4. How did God test Abraham? Why do you think God would ask such a thing? *Answer: When we are being tested is when we learn the most about our relationship with God.* Read  **Genesis 22:1-2**

5. What is faith? Did you know that faith pleases God very much? What does God promise to give those people that have faith?

Answer: He promises to bless those who obey Him.

Read  **Genesis 22:17-18**

6. When might a student your age need to trust God?

Wrap Up

Abraham and Sarah had to wait a long time for God to keep His promise to give them a son. But the Bible says Abraham believed. He had faith in God! God’s promises can always be trusted.

Memory Verse

"I trust in you Lord. I say you are my God!"

Psalm 31:14

Family Questions:

1. Who was the Bible story about and what happened in the story?
2. What was the Preschool Big Idea? *Answer: Faith means we trust God and believe that He is always our God.*
3. How did Abraham feel when God told him to kill Isaac as a sacrifice? *Answer: He was confused, but he still trusted God.*
4. How do I show faith? *Answer: I show faith everyday, when I trust and obey.*
5. What did the picture passes mean?
 - ▶ Clock— Show faith in God by waiting, even if it takes a long time.
 - ▶ Brain—We can remember God's promises and what He has done before so we can trust Him now.
 - ▶ See—When we choose Jesus as our leader, we get a seed of faith in our heart. Faith grows every time we trust, believe and obey God.

Explore God's Big Story

God told Abraham to sacrifice his son, but He provided a ram for Abraham to kill instead. In the same way, God provided the ultimate sacrifice for all of us: His Son, Jesus.

Prayer

Dear God, just like you provided for Abraham and spared Isaac, I know You will do the same for me when I trust you. Help me to remember this even when I am confused and scared. Amen.
